Scholarship Criteria for Clora Funeral Home Scholarship

- **Purpose:** The Clora Funeral Home Scholarship awards scholarships to college-bound high school seniors based on demonstrated academic achievement, and financial need.
- **Criteria:** The students eligible for assistance must be graduating high school seniors who reside in Michigan and intend to continue their education at an accredited institution of higher education. Consideration will be given based on academic achievement, financial need and the student's community service record. Students must submit the scholarship application form provided by Clora Funeral Home.
- **Guidelines:** Scholarships will be awarded on an annual basis and disbursed in full in June in the name of the institution and awardees.
- **Amount:** Each scholarship awarded will be a minimum of \$1,000 annually to be paid in one payment.

- **Deadline:** The application deadline is midnight on **July 10, 2019**. The deadline is the date after which applications will no longer be accepted. The Scholarship Committee uses the postmarked date to determine mailed entries.
- **Renewal process:** This scholarship is not renewable. Only high school seniors intending to enroll in a four-year college or university and then attend an accredited law school are eligible to apply. Previous scholarship recipients cannot re-apply.
- **Essay Question:** If resources were not an issue, what community need would you address, why, and how?
